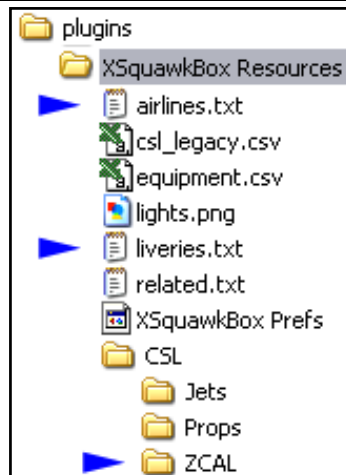

How to Connect to VATSIM or IVAO

Callsign – Type your airline call sign, CAX123 where 123 are the numbers assigned to you when you passed your Online Certification Check Ride.

Real Name – Your First and Last name

Server - IP of the server that you will be logging into

Port – 6809

ID – Your VATSIM or IVAO ID (depending on which network you are logging into)

Password – Your VATSIM or IVAO password (depending on which network you are logging into).

Model – Type the aircraft ICAO Code that you will be using (see the table above)


Airline - For California Airlines type “_CX” in the Airline box

Livery – The livery of the aircraft that you are flying. Choose “Generic” as the standard airline livery.

If you are flying with a trainer aircraft or EZ Rocket (C172, P28A, LGEZ)

Callsign – NCXxxx

xxx either being your assigned callsign (from when you passed the online check ride) or three numbers you want. For example my call sign is CAX8825. I would log in as **NCX825**

VATSIM or IVAO Connection Check List

1.	Run xplane and load your aircraft of choice.
2.	Place your aircraft on your airport of choice.
3.	Position the aircraft anywhere you like in the airport. Mak sure that you are not on any of the runways.
4.	Log into the VATSIM or IVAO network
5.	Enter your "call sign"
6.	Enter your "real name"
7.	Enter port 6809
8.	Enter your VATSIM or IVAO ID
9.	Enter your VATSIM or IVAO Password
10.	Enter your aircraft model
11.	Enter the name of the VA you are flying under (if none, leave blank and go to step 13)
12.	Enter the aircraft livery that you are using.
13.	Click on "Connect"
